If you asked a group of Christians to define “grace” you would probably get a lot of different answers. Some people talk of it as a substance you receive from God. Others understand it quite differently. After studying Scripture, Luther came to recognize that grace is not a substance – it is God’s disposition, His attitude, toward us. And that disposition is one of favor. Luther emphasized that by grace alone, by God’s disposition and favor alone, we are saved.
